

## 2018 LCCA Convention Coming to Greater Chicago

## Lionel Train Collectors to hold 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention

## At Westin Lombard Yorktown Center July 23-28

Greater Chicago, IL. – The Lionel Collectors Club of America (LCCA) National Convention will return to Chicagoland for the first time in 10 years. The model train collectors will headquarter their event at the Westin Lombard Yorktown Center and visit toy and real train-related attractions all over the Greater Chicago area during the last week of July.

Over 400 collectors and fans of the iconic Lionel model electric train brand are expected to register for the club's gathering in suburban Lombard.

The event will include model train layouts, seminars on all things model railroading, and presentations by executives of Lionel. And no model railroad convention would be complete without a swap meet. The LCCA will hold a two-day train show/swap meet in the convention hotel on Friday and Saturday, July 27 and 28. The event will be open to members only on Friday from 6 to 9 p.m. and open to the general public on Saturday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The convention will also include tours of Chicago area rail attractions during the week. LCCA members will have the opportunity to visit the Illinois Railway Museum in Union, the Chicago Museum of Science and Industry, the garden trains and musical instrument attractions at "Sanfilippo" Estate and The Wandering Tree Estate, see the massive O gauge model train layout of the Chicagoland Lionel Railroaders Club and ride on miniature outdoor trains at the Illinois Live Steamers' 7.3 acre park.

Members will also enjoy an architectural riverboat tour on the Chicago River, visit the historic Chicago Union Station and enjoy a moonlight dinner cruise on Lake Michigan.

"This year, the LCCA will be offering to 'share the fun' of the convention with other Chicago area model train clubs," said LCCA President and CEO Ken Kelley. Other model train club members can join the LCCA until July 1 and attend the convention with a special one-time rate of \$25 for a regular membership from July 1 until December 31. All additional standard convention registration fees will apply.
